Re: Request for Public Records

Dear Ms. Billingsley:

On behalf of the Oklahoma members of Americans United for Separation of Church and State, we request that the Oklahoma State Department of Education provide the documents requested below pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act, 51 O.S. § 24A.1 *et seq*.

Definitions

- 1. "Documents" means any record included in the law's definition of "public records," 51 O.S. § 24A.3(1).
- 2. "Department" means the Oklahoma State Department of Education or any of its officials, officers, boards or board members, councils, committees, administrators, agents, representatives, or employees.
- 3. "Prager" means Prager University Foundation—commonly known as PragerU—or any of its officials, officers, boards or board members, councils, committees, administrators, agents, representatives, or employees.

Document Requests

1. All documents relating or referring to the Department's review or approval of Prager materials for use in Oklahoma public schools. This request includes, but is not limited to, any documents analyzing Prager materials and any documents that reflect conclusions, recommendations, cautions, or concerns raised by such analysis.

- 2. All internal Department communications relating or referring to the review or approval of Prager materials for use in Oklahoma public schools.
- 3. All communications between the Department and Prager.

Instructions

1. If any documents are available electronically, we would appreciate it if you would send them to Ian Smith by electronic file transfer or by email at ismith@au.org. For documents that cannot be sent electronically, we would appreciate it if you would burn the documents to a DVD or CD and send the documents to the following address:
